Local

1. ____ **Bridgeport Rescue Mission** serves those who are homeless in Coastal CT. Each person and situation is unique so we meet people at the point of need offering solutions that help fight poverty from the inside out. *Missions Committee Liaison Position: open*

3. ____ **Council of Churches of Greater Bridgeport (CCGB):** Founded in 1945, a faith-based, non-sectarian social services agency dedicated to meeting the needs of people at risk and breaking the cycle of poverty and crisis in the Greater Bridgeport area. 1. ____ **Simba wa Yuda Academy** in Bulima, Tanzania is a large theological boarding school. It was founded 20 years ago as a school for mainly for the children of Tanzanian pastors and missionaries at Nassa Theological School. The school has grown from 10 children to nearly 850. Contributions are sent to the charitable organization, *The Lion of Judah Ministries*, which supports the Academy.
